Deadline to Register for the November 5, 2024 General Election Extended Office Hours

The deadline to register to vote in the 2024 General Election which will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, is quickly approaching as the voter registration books close on Monday, October 7, 2024. Gertrude Walker, St. Lucie County Supervisor of Elections, announced that Florida residents have the convenient opportunity to register to vote online until midnight on October 7, 2024, in order to participate in the General Election.

St. Lucie County residents can register to vote at any of the Supervisor of Elections four office locations from Monday through Friday to include extended hours on Saturday, October 5, 2024, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. In addition, all St. Lucie County Supervisor of Elections offices will be open from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm on October 7, 2024. Registration requirements to vote in St. Lucie County are listed below:

- U.S. Citizen and resident of Florida and St. Lucie County
- At least 18 years old
- Not adjudicated mentally incapacitated, or if so, voting rights restored
- Not be convicted of a felony, or if so, voting rights restored

Supervisor Walker is optimistic that residents of St. Lucie County will take advantage of the extended office hours to register prior to the upcoming deadline. The St. Lucie County Supervisor of Elections offices are located at:
